Joseph James Fazzone, born in 1911, was a Schenectady resident, and worked as a cobbler on Broadway until 1942. He and Bertha married c. 1930, but had no issue. A framed Honorable Discharge certificate dated October 26, 1945, noted his rank as Seaman Second Class, USNR.
