## **Organizational/Business Records and Personal Papers**

Larry Hart Collection (Accession no. 2006.4)

Includes research files, photographs, and postcards related to doctors, nursing, medical history, and of the Bellevue, Ellis, Glenridge, St. Clare's, and Sunnyview hospitals. The collection also includes audio recordings featuring Henry A. Kerste, a local druggist.

Kerste Drug Store Records

Relevant materials consist of receipts for medical treatment.
