<u>Abstract</u>: The collection is composed of memorabilia and records of the Monday Garden Group of Schenectady, part of the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State.

## Scope and Content Note:

The collection is composed of memorabilia and records of the Monday Garden Group of Schenectady. The majority of the contents are bylaws, minutes, membership records and "yearbooks." In addition there are several event programs, a collection of presentations and speeches, awards and photographs. The collection also includes publications and correspondence from the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State (FGCNYS) and the FGCNYS' Third District, both headquartered in Albany County.

## Organization History:

From information found in the records, we know that the club began as the Monday Garden Group in 1940. The club records continue through the early 2000's. Additionally the club was part of the Third District of the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State.

#### Condition Note:

Most of the materials are in fair to good condition. Some of the paper documents are on onion skin paper and are fragile.

<u>Related/Separated Materials</u>: Materials pertaining to the National Council of Garden Clubs, 15 issues of *The National Gardener*, general gardening and ecology reference material, and other materials not pertaining to the Monday Garden Group of Schenectady or to the Federated Garden Clubs of New York State have been removed from the collection.
