Scope and Content Note:

The collection is composed of photographs and World War II memorabilia related to Edward E. Oliver and photographs of members of the Oliver and Hempstead families. The collection includes photographs of Lillian Hempstead Oliver (1878-1967), mother of Edward Oliver; Edward Wright Hempstead (1855-1923) and Elthea Canfield Hempstead (1848-1923), maternal grandparents of Edward Oliver; Francis E Oliver (1867-1955), father of Edward Oliver; George Oliver and Amanda Hubbell Oliver, paternal grandparents of Edward Oliver. The collection also includes photographs, letters, and memorabilia regarding Oliver's WWII service on the U.S.S. *Lauderdale*.

Biographical Note:

Edward Elliot "Ned" Oliver was born in 1911 in Syracuse, New York, to Francis and Lillian (Hempstead) Oliver. He graduated from Shaw High School in Cleveland, Ohio in

1930 and graduated from Syracuse University in 1934 with a degree in finance. After finishing his schooling, he began working for General Electric's district office in New York City. In 1943, he resigned from his position as a general manager to enlist in the U.S. Navy. He served in the Navy's supply department; from December 1944 until his discharge in December 1945, he served as Supply Officer for the U.S.S. *Lauderdale*. Oliver rejoined General Electric in 1946, working in sales promotion and advertising in Schenectady until his retirement in 1974. Oliver was also actively involved in YMCA youth programs for over 30 years, including service as Camp Chingachgook committee chair from 1959-1975 and Schenectady YMCA President from 1976-1986. Oliver died in 1997 and was survived by his wife of over 50 years, Janet.
